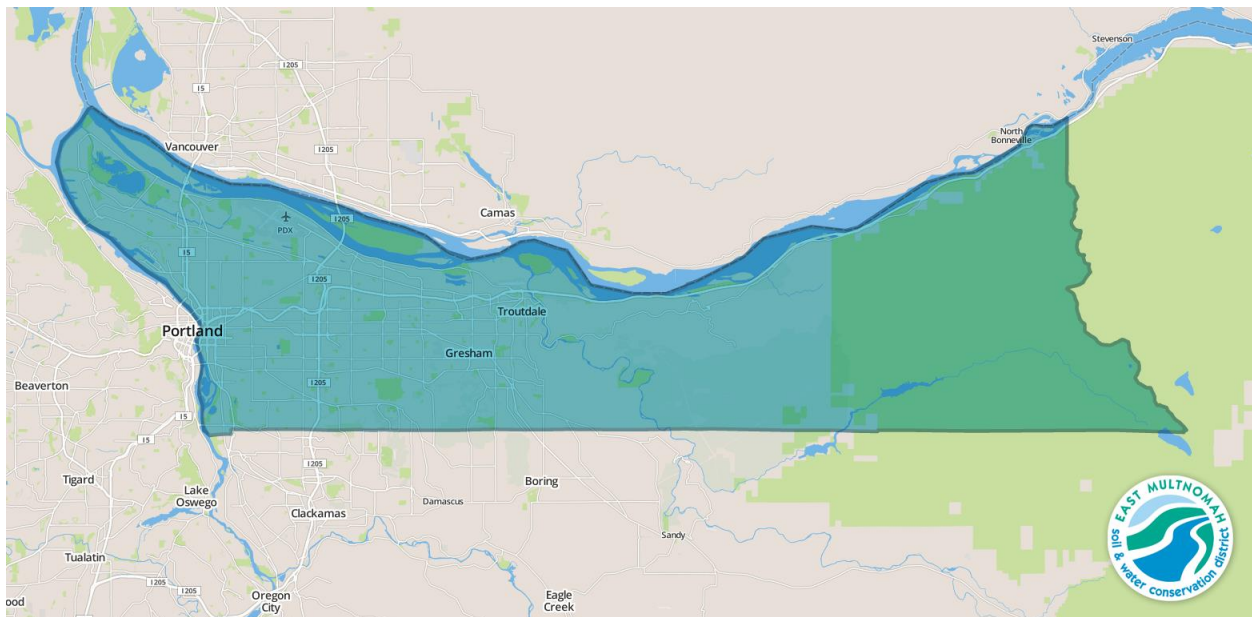

Agenda items include: Best practices for individual board member information requests and discussions with staff, Equity Team Update, FY19-20 budget adoption, request for approval of Rural Lands (StreamCare/Weed Control) contracts, request for approval for adoption of the Agricultural Management Plan guidelines, potential update on NAYA project, potential request to sign onto support letter for State Flood Mitigation Revolving Fund legislation, Executive Sessions under ORS 192.660(2)(e) to deliberate with persons designated to negotiate real property transactions, under ORS 192.660(2)(h) concerning potential litigation and under ORS 192.660(2)(f) to discuss written attorney-client privileged advice exempt from public inspection under ORS 192.355(9), under ORS 192.660(2)(f) to discuss internal advisory communications exempt from public inspection under ORS 192.355(1), and to discuss and approve matters related to the review, evaluation and performance of the Executive Director.
