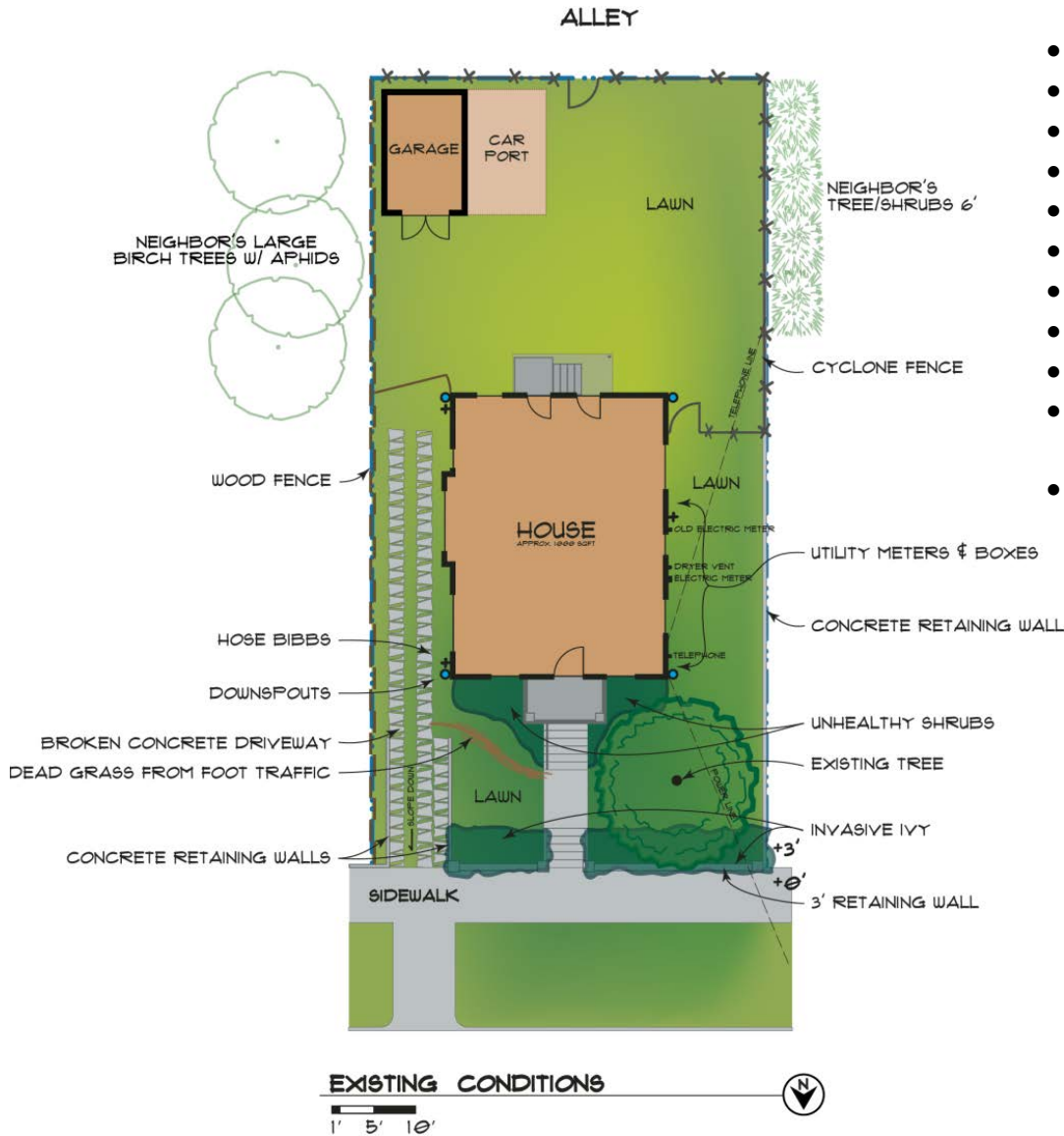


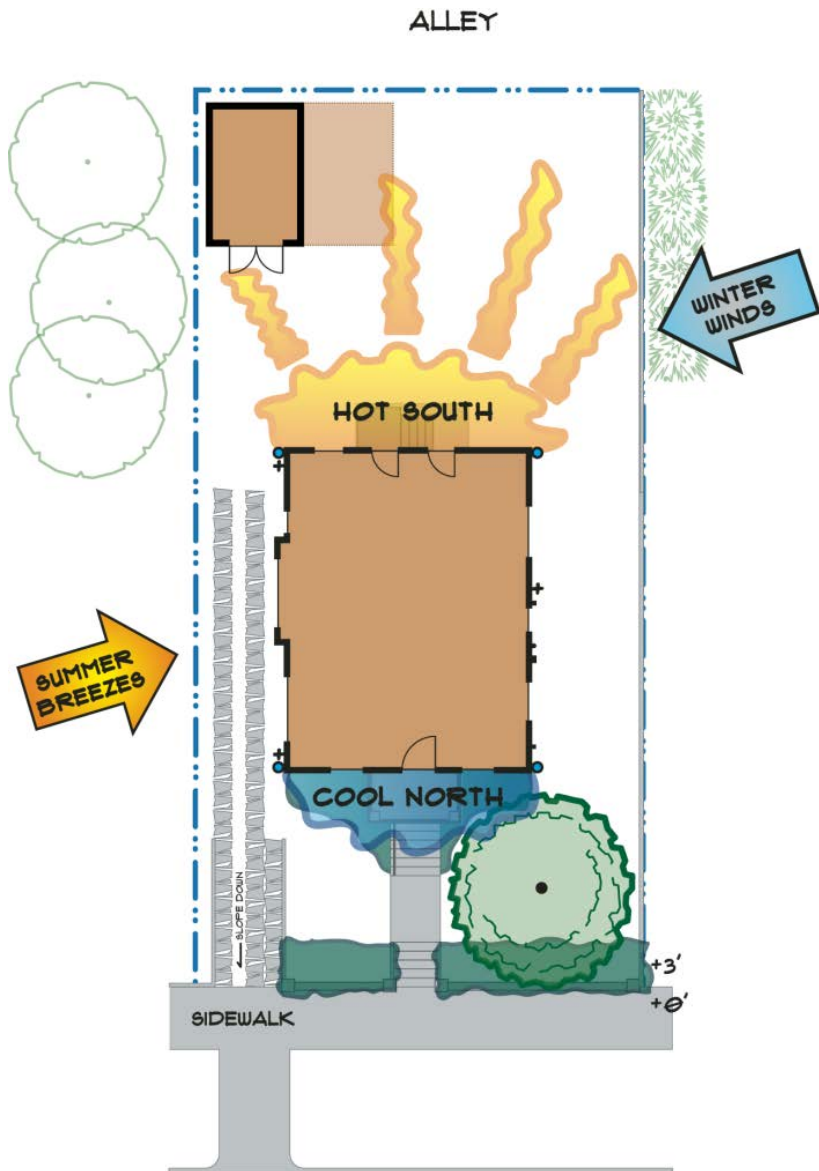
# STEP 1

Things to include in your Existing Conditions/Base map:



- Property lines
- Permanent structures (house, garage, etc.)
- Paved or impervious surfaces (driveways, patios, etc.)
- Significant slopes, hills, or ditches
- Water bibs/spigots
- Downspouts
- Utility access points
- Existing plants and planting beds
- Potential sources of pollution/contamination
- Adjacent structures or plants that impact your property (tall buildings, tall trees, spreading invasive species plants, etc.)
- North arrow

## STEP 2



Things to include in your **Environmental Factors/Exposure** overlay:

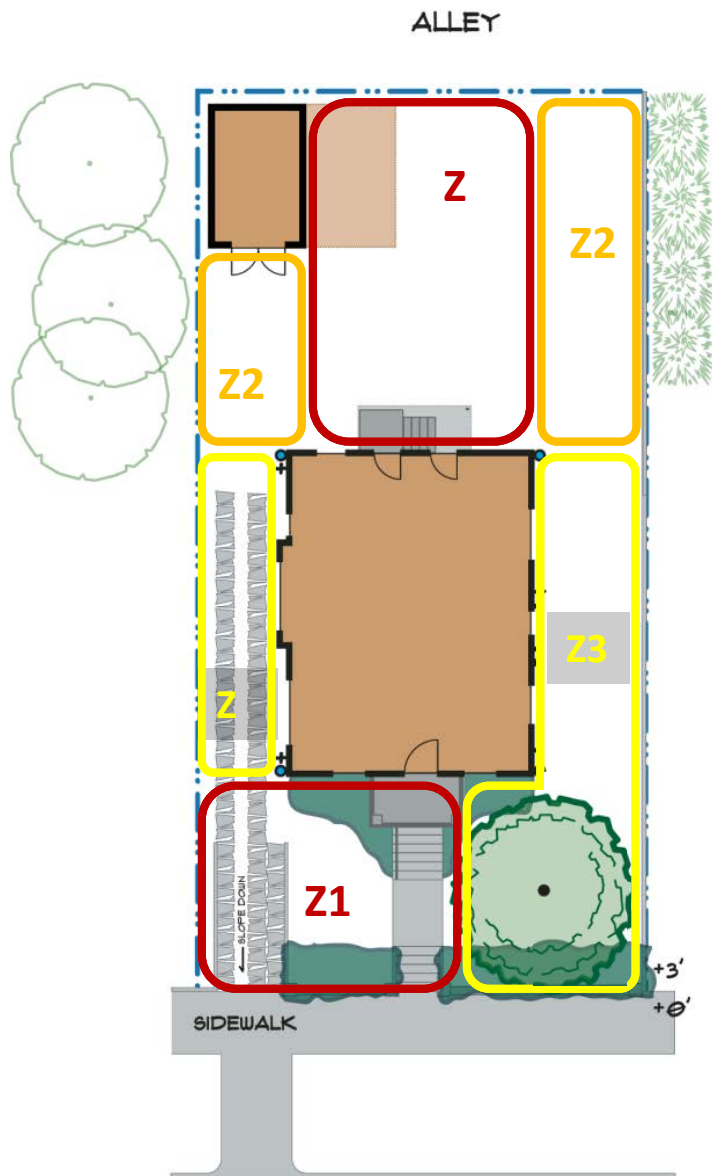
- Hot/Cool spots
- Bright/Shady areas
- Seasonal wind patterns
- Soil type (primarily sand, silt, clay, or a balanced mix)
- Drainage (runoff/erosion, poor drainage, fast drainage, etc.)
- Wildlife movement

- Zone 3 - Visited monthly

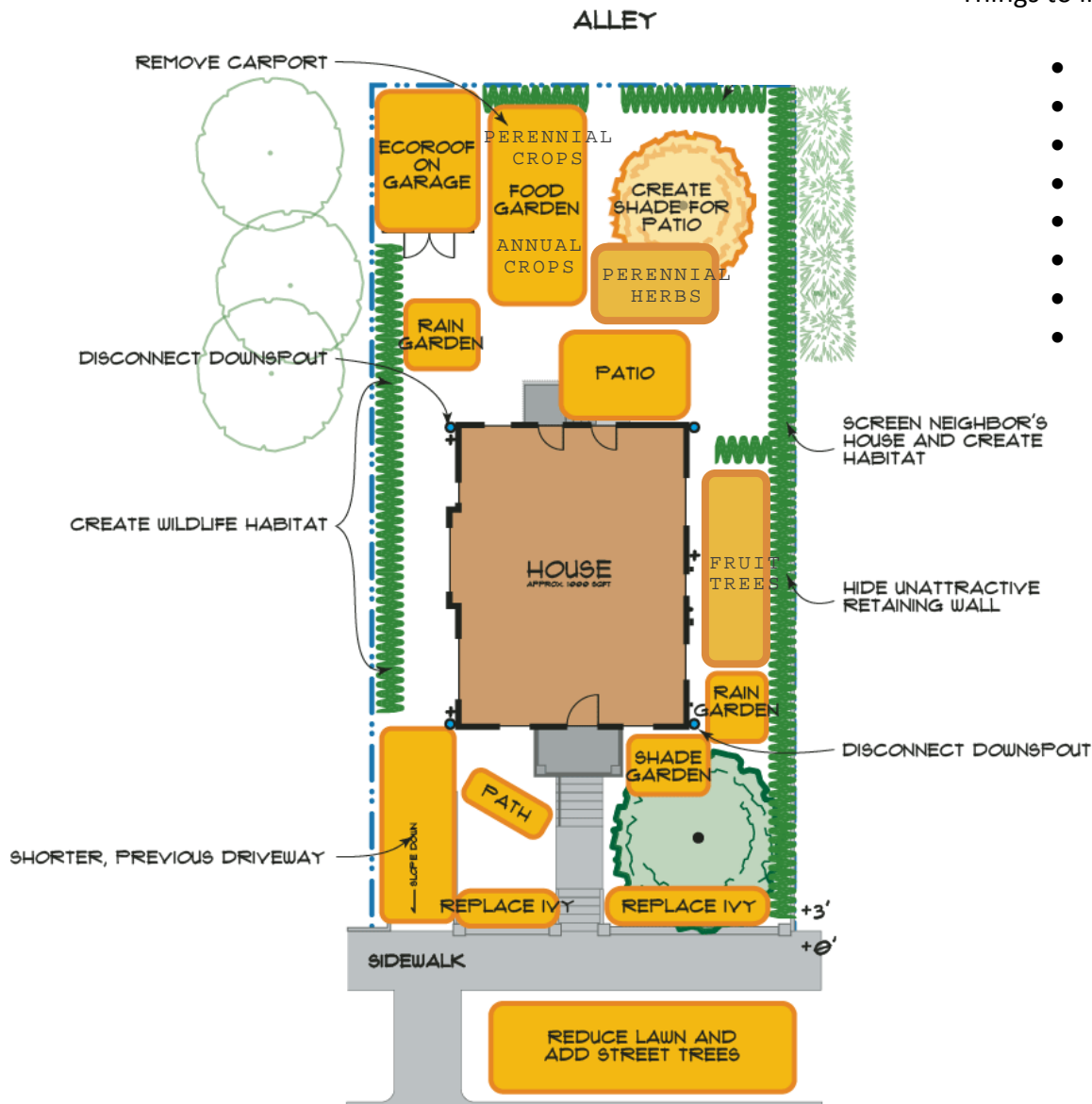
SITE ASSESSMENT: ZONES
