## East Multnomah Soil and Water Conservation District Land Legacy Committee Meeting, April 17th, 2023

The East Multnomah Soil and Water Conservation District (EMSWCD), which serves all of Multnomah County east of the Willamette River, will hold a Land Legacy Committee meeting on April 17<sup>th</sup>, 2023. This meeting is open to the public and all persons interested in the work of EMSWCD are invited to join the meeting at the EMSWCD Office at 5211 N Williams Ave, Portland, OR 97217. Attendees of this meeting may be asked to wear a mask while inside the EMSWCD Office.

The meeting of the Land Legacy Committee is scheduled for 4:00 PM on Monday, April 17<sup>th</sup>. The Land Legacy Committee will be discussing the irrigation well at the Oxbow Farm property, challenges and potential strategies associated with EMSWCD's working farmland protection program, an outreach plan for EMSWCD's working farmland protection program, and an Executive Session under ORS 192.660(2)(e) held for real estate negotiations.
